CREATING UNIQUE LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

Children and Youth who experience blindness and visual impairment can learn to navigate the world in their own unique way. Our programs build confidence and independence through specialized curriculum, fostering relationships with peers, and mentoring.

The Transition to Work Program provides individualized vocational and job skills training. Students enroll through local school district partnerships and parent referrals.

Students engage in a unique learning environment which encourages them to achieve their individual maximum potential. Students receive hands on learning through simulation of various career situations and job tasks.

CRITERIA:

-  Students must be 16-22 years of age
-  Experience a vision or other disability
-  Be self-sufficient for toileting and eating
-  Travel independently
-  Demonstrate Appropriate Behavior
